

SCRUFF

In order to comply with App Store content regulations, event artwork must not contain any of the items below in order to be approved and promoted on SCRUFF.



No Nudity

All genitals, breasts, and butts, even barely visible or visible from the side.



No Sexual

Images that depict anything sexual, real, or simulated.



No Visible Penis Line

This includes soft or hard genitals where the penis line is visible through any clothing. A bulge of any kind is not allowed.

Underwear and swimwear are allowed as long as there is no visible penis line or bulge.



No Pubic Hair.

No visible pubic hair at all. Even a small amount showing at the top of the waistline, or underwear, and swimwear.



No Crotch Focus

Images that focus on the butt or butt outline, such as a butt-only photo or photos of twerking.



No Hardcore Fetish Gear

Sex toys, rope bondage, and gimp-style face masks.

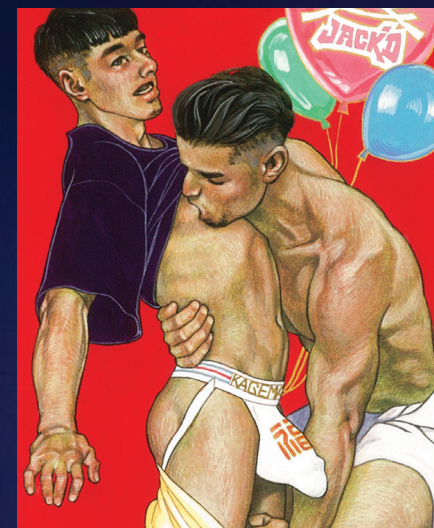
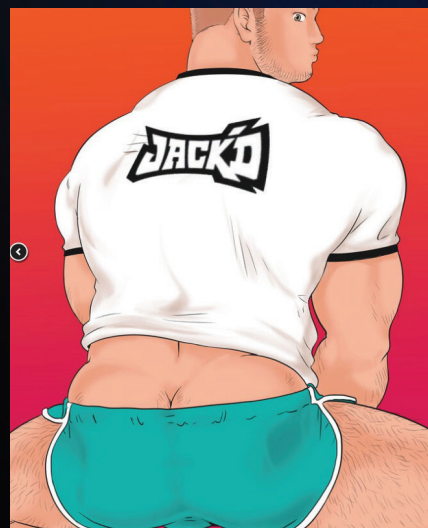
Harnesses are allowed.



No Stripping

Any photo of someone lifting their shirt or taking off or pulling down any part of their clothing is not allowed.

Shirtless models are allowed.



***Please note that cartoons, illustrations, AI, or any other image creations should also follow the above guidelines.**

Note that event rejection due to one of the reasons above is not a permanent rejection. Simply edit your artwork to meet the guidelines above, and then resubmit your event for approval.

- Crop out the bottom part of your model.
- Cover up the bottom part of your model using any graphic design tool like letters, objects, blurred, etc.
- Go for a typographic approach using the name of your party.

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
